








Why KE between HE and SMEs?

- 2000 to 2009:
 - 37% growth from inputs, 63% from innovation
 - £24bn collapse in R&D No long tail
- Scotland Low BERD v High HERD
- 98% firms in private sector economy are SMEs
- Gap in provision
- Long term fundamental problems...

1. where ideas meet at the point of creation.


2. *Cell Biology.* a biological term where two Chromatids overlap in the process of meiosis.

3. *Design in Action.* residential innovation events where people often with wildly different craft skills come together to solve complex problems by generating new and often elegantly simple ideas.




- 3 projects have launched (so far)...


