



## Participants guide to the CHEAD Annual Conference 2021

The CHEAD Annual Conference 2021 is online this year.

For the best experience, we recommend using a laptop or stationary computer and the Google Chrome browser (download).

We are using a bespoke conference platform with three main areas:

- **Conference session timetable** – located on the main page with three dates identified. A red line will indicate where you are in the session timetable.
- **Resources Gallery 'Always On'** – located on the right hand side menu, this area includes virtual tours, exhibition highlights and messages from key partners.
- **Partners Area** – explore this area to find more about our featured partners – [APDIG](#), [AA2A](#), [ArtsThread](#) and [FACE](#) and to access the 'Always On' content.

### How to access the conference platform:

- Search for an email from with Subject 'CHEAD Annual Conference' in your inbox which was sent at 5pm on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> March. Please check your SPAM folder if you can't locate it.
- Follow the link supplied and enter you email and app pin:
